



Your coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccination status

Depending on your age and vaccination status, you may be exempt from the requirement to self-isolate and take a Day 8 test upon your arrival in England from an amber country, provided you have not been to a red country in the 10 days prior to your arrival. If you are a participant in a formally approved COVID-19 vaccine trial you may also be entitled to this exemption.

Please check whether you meet the eligibility criteria for the exemption here.

The exemption will only apply if you provide acceptable proof that you meet the necessary requirements during travel. Acceptable proof (i.e. of vaccination status or your participation in a formally approved COVID-19 vaccine clinical trial) is listed <u>here</u>.

Please note that exemption from self-isolation and Day 8 testing only applies for the duration of your stay in England. If you travel onwards to Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland, or a Crown Dependency, different rules may apply. You can check the travel requirements for <u>Scotland</u>, <u>Wales</u> and <u>Northern Ireland</u>.





Self-isolation in the UK

You may need to self-isolate when you arrive in the UK depending on the countries or islands you enter in the 10 days before you travel.

If you have been in a medium risk (amber) list country or island at any point in the 10 days before you travel, you must self-isolate when you arrive in the UK, unless you are exempt. You can <u>check if you are travelling for an exempt reason and do not need to self-isolate</u>.

If you have only been in low risk (green) list countries or islands in the 10 days before you travel, you do not need to self-isolate.

If you will self-isolate in England, you can use the Test to Release scheme. This could reduce how long you need to self-isolate for.

If you choose to use Test to Release, <u>book an extra coronavirus test from an</u> <u>approved Test to Release provider</u>.

You must still take the 2 other coronavirus tests you booked for after you arrive in the UK, even if your Test to Release result means you can end self-isolation early.


